### Visiting Professorship In Nutrition Program

The National Dairy Council announces its annual Visiting Professorship in Nutrition program. Schools of medicine are invited to submit competitive applications for participation in this program in the calendar year 1983.

The purpose of this program is to enhance the present level of nutrition knowledge of physicians, medical students, and other health care professionals by sponsoring visits by individuals with expertise in nutrition-related medical problems at medical schools throughout the country.

The program is designed to create a greater awareness of the importance of nutrition to clinical medicine and other closely related specialties, and also to foster greater inter-institutional and interdepartmental communication of nutrition concepts and their application to modern health care.

A list of available visiting professors from which the medical school can select has been developed. An honorarium of \$500 and travel expenses up to \$1000 are supported by NDC.

Applications for the calendar year 1983 program are due on or before *October 1, 1982*.

### Awards of the Society

The American Society for Clinical Nutrition currently administers two awards for research in clinical nutrition. Nominations may be made by anyone, and nominees need not be members of the Society. Nominations must consist of a letter, signed by the nominator, outlining the basis for the nomination, a list of *published* papers that are immediately pertinent to the nomination, reprints of those papers that most effectively support the basis for the nomination, and the nominee's curriculum vitae. Each of these must be submitted in *five* copies and be received not later than October 1, 1982 for consideration for awards to be given in 1983.

The McCollum Award of the American Society for Clinical Nutrition is given to an original clinical investigator, generally perceived as currently a major creative force, actively generating new concepts in nutrition, and personally seeing to the execution of studies testing the validity of these concepts. The McCollum Award, administered by the Society and sponsored by the National Dairy

Council, consists of \$1,000 and an inscribed scroll presented during a ceremony held in conjunction with the Annual Meeting of the Society each year.

The Robert H. Herman Award in Clinical Nutrition is given to a clinical investigator whose research work has contributed importantly to the advancement of clinical nutrition in areas particularly involving the biochemical and metabolic aspects of human nutrition. The Robert H. Herman Award in Clinical Nutrition is administered by the Society and sponsored by the Robert H. Herman Memorial Fund established by the Society and Mrs. Yaye Tokuyama Herman. It consists of \$1,000 and an inscribed scroll presented during a ceremony held in conjunction with the Annual Meeting of the Society each year.
