Second Graduate Institute on Nutrition

The Second Graduate Institute on Nutrition, Ochsner Foundation Hospital, 1516 Jefferson Highway, New Orleans, Louisiana will be held on March 11-13, 1970, and is cosponsored by the Louisiana Dietetic Association and the Alton Ochsner Medical Foundation. There will be continuing education clock hours to count toward A.D.A. registration. The meeting is open only to A.D.A. members.
